Description of Services:

Transthoracic Echocardiogram - an ultrasound examination of the heart. A technologist take images of your heart, which are reviewed by the cardiologist.

Stress Echocardiogram, Treadmill - ECG is monitored as the speed and grade of the treadmill is gradually increased, with an ultrasound examination of the heart before and immediately after exercise. The images of the heart are correlated with any ECG changes to determine any limitation of blood flow to the heart, and are reviewed by the cardiologist.

Stress Echocardiogram, Dobutamine - like the treadmill stress echocardiogram, except Dobutamine is used to duplicate exercise results for patients who cannot perform exercise.

ABI (Ankle Brachial Index) - performed by measuring blood pressures in the arms and legs while at rest. The result is used to predict the severity of peripheral artery disease, and is reviewed by the cardiologist.

Stress ABI - performed by measuring blood pressures in the arms and legs after exercise. The result is used to predict the severity of peripheral artery disease. Reviewed by the cardiologist.

Stress Cardiolute (nuclear) Treadmill - nuclear scan of the heart is performed before and after treadmill exercise. A very small dose of radioactive tracer is injected before each scan through an I.V. A camera rotates around the chest and images of the blood flow are taken and reviewed by the cardiologist.

Stress Cardiolute (nuclear) Lexiscan - like the Cardiolute Treadmill test, but the nuclear scan of the heart is performed before and after I.V. injection of Lexiscan, which duplicates the results of exercise.

Stress Cardiolute (nuclear) Dobutamine - like the Cardiolute Treadmill test, but the nuclear scan of the heart is performed before and after I.V. injection of Dobutamine, which duplicates the results of exercise.

MUGA - a small dose of radioactive tracer is injected through an I.V. It mixes with the blood in the heart chambers. Images taken during each phase of the heartbeat allow calculation of the amount of blood ejected with each beat, the ejection fraction, the most commonly used measurement of heart function. Reviewed by the cardiologist.
